Pupil ICT Agreement Form

This agreement should be taken as part of the overall strategy of the school and operated within the context of our vision, aims and values as a Church of England School.

At Wrington C of E Primary School, we expect all pupils to be responsible for their own behaviour on the Internet, just as they are elsewhere in school. This includes materials they choose to access and language they use.

- When using the **Internet** you are expected not to deliberately seek out offensive materials. If you come across any unsuitable material accidentally, you must report it immediately to a teacher.
- You must not use any rude language in e-mail communications or any computer work and contact only people the teacher has approved.
- You must ask permission before accessing the Internet.
- Avoid copying and pasting text or images that you have not created yourself, without saying where it has come from, and be aware that some websites may be biased.

General Computer Use

- You should not access other people's files unless you have permission.
- You must follow the teacher's instructions for using any ICT equipment.
- Computers should only be used for school work and homework unless permission has been granted otherwise.
- Program files may not be downloaded to the computer from the Internet unless permission is given by the teacher.
- No programs on disc or CD-ROM should be brought in from home for use in school.
- You must ask permission before printing as it can be very expensive. Save your work instead.
- You must not bring any mobile phones, cameras or other hand-held devices into school unless specifically asked to by the class teacher. On those occasions, you must follow the teacher's instructions about appropriate use.
- Never give out personal information such as phone numbers and addresses or arrange to meet someone via a computer.

If you do not act responsibly you may not be allowed to use the school's computers in future.
