Thursday 23rd November – Y6 trip to Bristol Cathedral

As part of our RE Unit on "how should we live and who can inspire us?", we have planned a trip to Bristol on the above date. We will be out of school for the whole day and returning by the usual end time, subject to traffic.

Our day will begin at Bristol Cathedral looking at the city's slave trade history and the work of the Abolitionists. After lunch, we will walk across to the New Rooms in Broadmead to learn about John Wesley and the Methodists. We will visit the museum and find out about John Wesley's links with the Abolition movement and William Wilberforce.

This will be an excellent opportunity for the children to find out more about Bristol's history and also to reflect on the relevance of Wesley's principles for today's world.

The cost of this trip is £14 per child and this will include transport and admission costs together with the workshops that have been booked.
