

Churchill Cluster Review 2013-2014

- OAA – Outdoor and Adventurous activities
- Term 4 - Year 4 – Gifted and Talented – working together as a team – applying tactics
- Leadership and Responsibility – 4 hour leadership model – preparing pupils to support / lead their own and other PE lessons – officiating warm-ups and ‘key’ skills.

- Year 3 – 2 sessions – CPD for SG – Multi-skills and gym – teacher given lots of ideas.

- PM is a familiar face for those children going to Churchill – children also have opportunity to go to the school for sporting fixtures and familiarise themselves with the surroundings.
