- Our Collective Worship is varied throughout the week with worship through song, weekly clergy services, whole school celebration service, class service and Key Stage services led by the Head teacher.
- Special festivals (e.g. Easter, Ash Wednesday, Pentecost, Harvest...) are celebrated in school, at our foundation church, All Saints' or the United Reformed Chapel. We have enjoyed taking part in special services in the community such as the Village Fair Thanksgiving Service or Remembrance.
- Each class leads worship for the whole school once a year to which parents are invited.
- We occasionally have our Collective Worship outside, either on our playing field or on the playground, and invite the community to join us as it is a bit of a squeeze in our school hall!
- We use the themes from the 'Twelve Baskets' publications as the basis of our worship plan, incorporating other topics as appropriate.
- We are very fortunate to be supported by clergy and other parishioners who lead worship following our weekly theme.
- Although our worship is predominantly Christian, we warmly welcome visitors from other faiths.
- There is a focus area or display for personal spiritual reflection in each classroom and in our welcome area.
