

Maths Curriculum

Here at Wrington Church of England Primary School we take pride in the fact that we aim to enjoy and have fun with maths. Confidence and a favourable attitude are encouraged by allowing children to actively participate in the learning process, thus creating a sense of achievement.

Arithmetic and Problem Solving and Reasoning skills are developed through the teaching of many strategies. Children are encouraged to experiment with different methods and explain the reasoning behind their answers. Children are then given opportunities to use and apply mathematics in real life situations. By the time children reach Year 6 they are making valuable connections between all areas of the maths curriculum.

Class teachers use the White Rose Maths overview to ensure that coverage as well as depth is included in their teaching. We also plan for opportunities to develop and apply key mathematical skills in other subjects throughout the year.
