Please note that the assessment format and criteria of reading, writing and maths at the end of Key Stage 1 and 2 SATs has changed this year and we have been advised that comparisons in attainment with last year can no longer be made. We include national data where possible for comparison.

Phonics check in Year 1:

80% of children reached the required phonics standard

90% of children reached the required phonics standard
